Wattles in Flower Everywhere

Have you noticed how many different Wattles are flowering at the moment?

The large Sydney Green Wattles (Acacia decurrens) have masses of bright yellow flowers, the Sweet Scented Wattle (Acacia suaveolens) is a much smaller Wattle with scented creamy flowers. The Myrtle Wattle (Acacia myrtifolia) is another small attractive shrub with pale yellow flowers and attractive reddish



stems. Some of the prickly leaved wattles like Prickly Moses (Acacia ulicifolia) and the Spike Wattle (Acacia oxycedrus) are not holding back on their floral displays at this time of the year and they also provide protective habitat to small birds all year round. The White Sally Wattle (Acacia floribunda) with its pale yellow flowers that is commonly found near creeks and rivers has also being planted in parks and gardens. The Sydney Golden Wattle (Acacia longifolia) with bright yellow showy flowers and the Coast Myall (Acacia binervia) with attractive silvery blue foliage and bright yellow flowers are hard to miss.

Our district is home to many more wattle species, some of them are small shrubs and others grow to small tree size. All Wattles share a reputation for being tough plants that are fast growers with showy masses of flowers.

Throughout history Wattles have been of great use to man. Some local species of Wattle are used as food by roasting the seed and chewing its gum, bark of some species being used as a tea. The Aboriginals used the macerated leaves and bark of wattles to stun fish and the long flexible branches of some species were used to build shelters. To our colonial settlers the Wattle became a major industry being a good source of local tannin for the leather industry.
